Bonnie Griffie, daughter of John C. Griffie and the late Elva Watts Griffie, was born at Hallie, Ky. June 13, 1925. She passed from this life at her residence Tuesday, July 28, 1987 being 62 years, one month and 15 days of age at the time of her passing.
