

Obituary

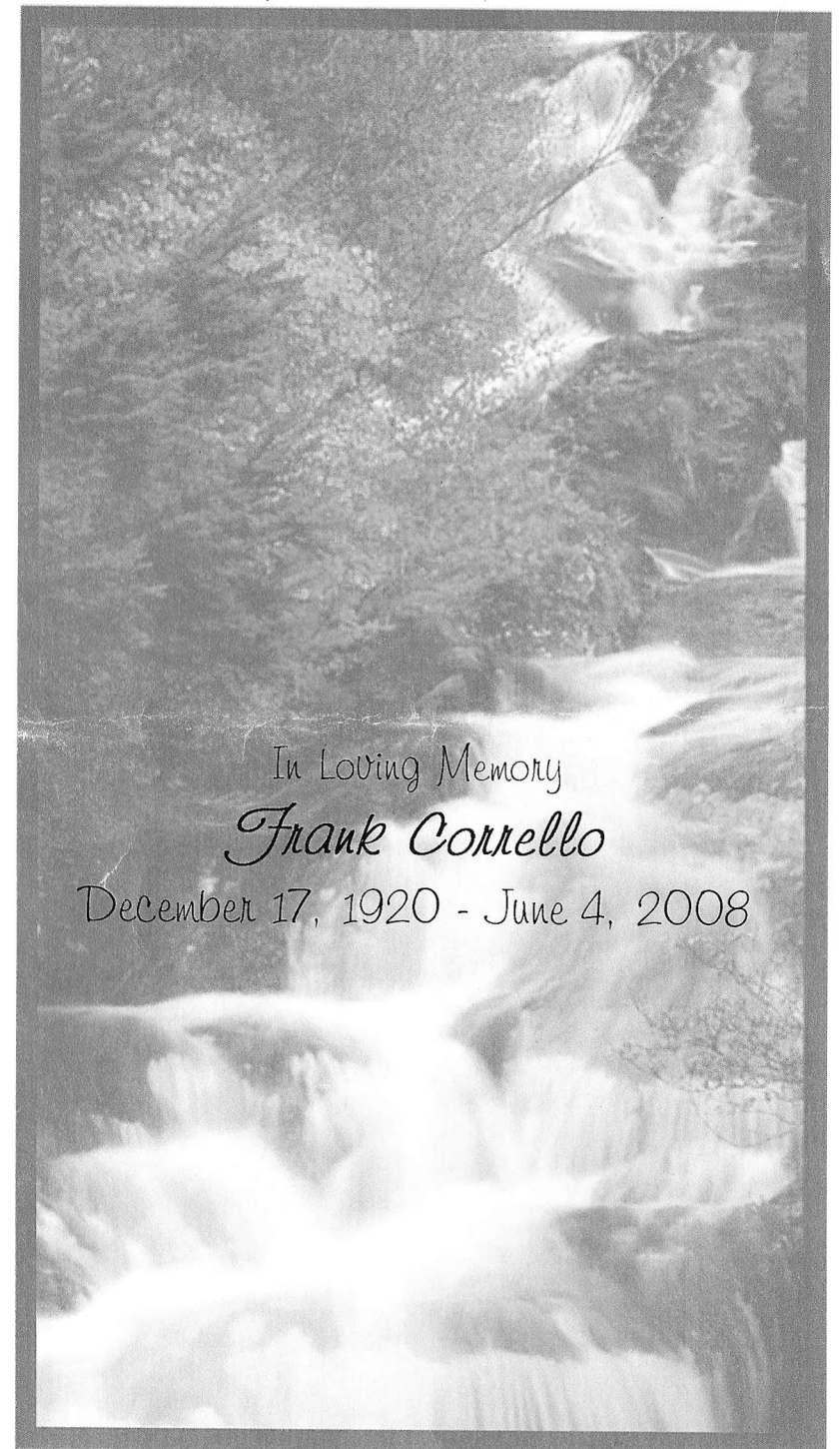
