

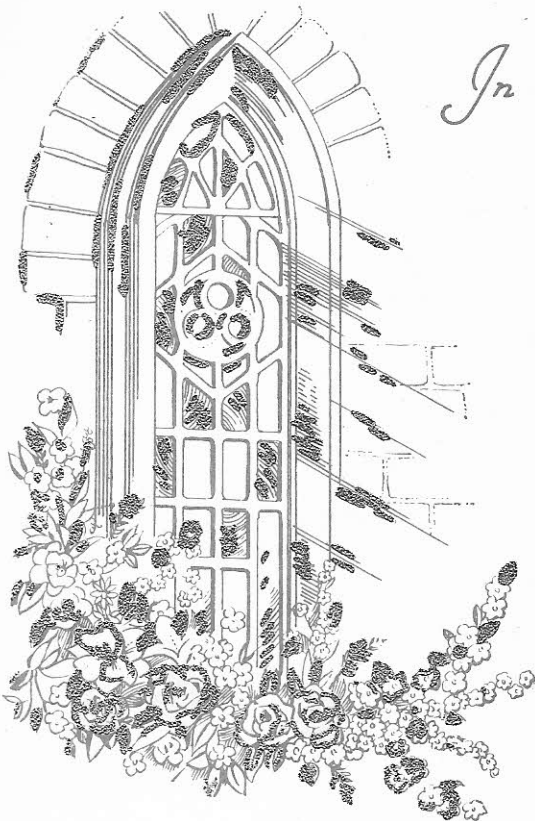
OBITUARY
