He was born November 11, 1897, being 78 years, 8 months and 8 days of age at the time of his passing.

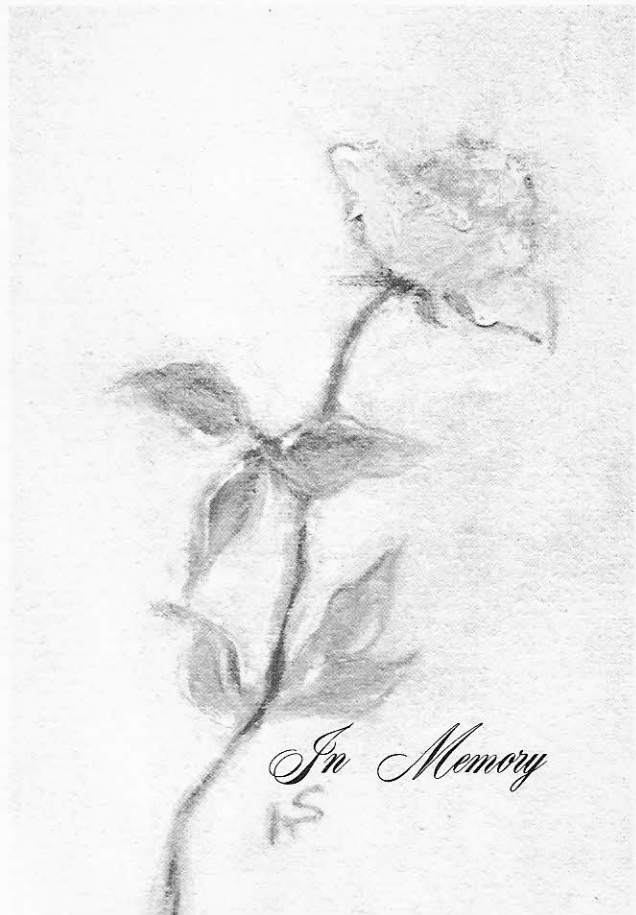
